After checking into either the **Hilton**, Northbridge Hotel or a Quest Apartment, put on your fancy threads and taxi on over to bar snacks.

Serious foodies won't be able to resist at Must or join in the migration of punters heading on foot down Beaufort Street to the stylish Luxe Bar for cocktails and slinking

**Once considered** a bit dull, the blossoming capital of Western Australia proves to be anything but

the **Must Winebar** for some serious bubbles in the swanky upstairs Champagne Room. Once you're suitably relaxed, head downstairs to the bistro where you'll find French provincial fare, or prop yourself up at the winebar for some tasty

**Jackson's**, just a few steps away, or across the road is **Two Fat Indians**. Resume your position around.




Hopefully sleep came soundly because it's time for breakfast at Fraser's Restaurant in Kings Park, Perth's answer to New York's Central Park. If your state is still precarious after breakfast, find a quiet and sunny spot to flop down, or the intrepid can walk among the treetops at the **Lotterywest Federation Walkway**. Either walk down or grab a taxi to The Old Swan Brewery complex, housing **The Old Brewery Grill**, Perth's premier steakhouse, and Zafferano Restaurant, serving Italian seafood.

Now it's time for some retail therapy in the city. For street fashion visit the arcades and department stores in the Hay Street and Murray Street malls, including the historic **London Court**, which houses **Devlin's Cigars**. Then wander up to the west end of Hay Street and take a detour down King Street, where you'll find 20thcentury architecture and designers like Tiffany & Co. and the edgy Australian label Ruth Tarvydas. Stop for coffee along the way at **Tiger, Tiger** and return to your hotel for a pit-stop and an outfit change.







### Sunday

Savour a breakfast of champions at either the **Bluewater Grill**, overlooking the river, or **Indiana**, perched on the edge of the Indian Ocean. Afterwards, head 20 kilometres southwest of Perth to **Fremantle**, the home of the bohemian, where your hangover will be in good company. Spend the morning at the Maritime Musuem or simply wander around the back streets exploring the **New Edition Bookshop**, onetime prison **The** Round House, various guirky shops, and the colonial architecture.

When you feel those rumblings within, head to the buzzing Little Creatures Brewery at the Fremantle **Fishing Boat Harbour**. After lunch, puruse the markets and hang out with the buskers on the busy **Cappuccino Strip.** Finally, head back to the harbour for an idyllic end to a getaway in the west with fish'n'chips and the sunset.

### **Saturday Night**

If you've got the stamina for a feast of epic proportions, then Perth's best awaits at **Restaurant Amusé** – and bookings are essential. Those with modest tastes will adore Nahm Thai or **Andaluz Bar and Tapas.** To round things off, get trumpetted away at **Ellington's Jazz Club**. Book a table or go for standing room only and prepare to be overwhelmed by the talented local and international acts.

For alternative entertainment try **Deville's Pad**, a kitschy club offering themed nights and live entertainment; dancing and devilry is encouraged. If you've got money to burn, visit the casino that never closes at the Burswood Entertainment Complex.
